53 members from 17 countries, with an average H-index of 54.8.

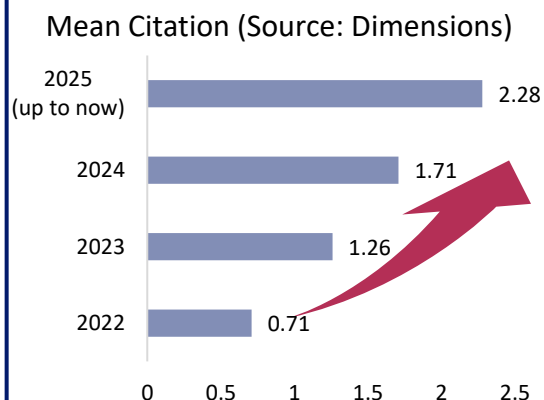
