51 members from 16 countries, with an average H-index of 55.



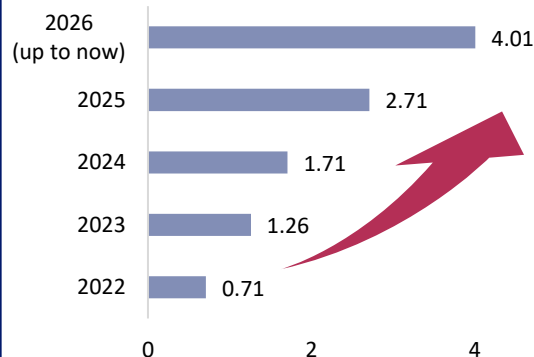

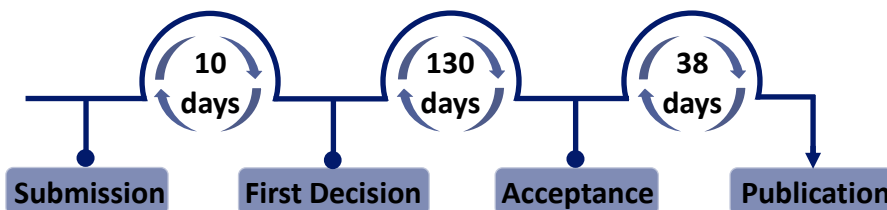
